

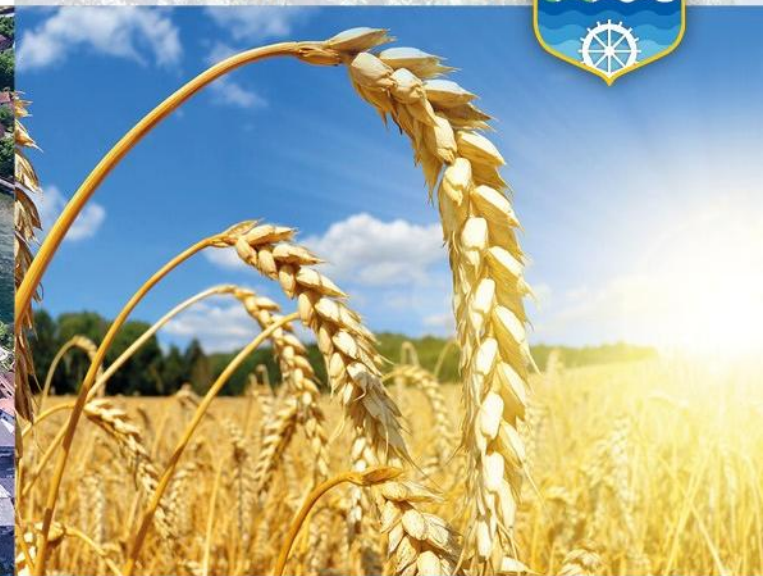

Mixed husbandry-livestock production systems are dominant in the agricultural production. The leading culture in the structure of sowing areas are corn and wheat, farms have a few head of cattle and are included in the milk supply chain to processors. Products from livestock (milk and meat) are the main sources of cash income from agriculture. Of the total number of households (5.000), about 2/3 of the farms.
